Award Purpose

The Marblehead Festival of Arts offers a \$3,000 scholarship to aid a deserving high school senior who resides or attends high school in Marblehead and who is pursuing higher education in visual or performing arts, crafts, or music. The objective of the Marblehead Festival of Arts, in awarding this scholarship, is to encourage the high school graduate interested in pursuing the arts professionally, to acquire sound academic grounding in his/her field of choice.

Award Criteria

The Marblehead Festival of Arts Scholarship Committee will consider financial need, general academic and arts achievement, activities both in and outside of school (arts-related and other), honors and/or special citations received and intended vocation. All information will be kept confidential.

Application Process

Please complete the attached form and provide the following required information as supplemental attachments (*in order*). All submissions must be typed. Piecemeal applications will not be accepted.

Essay

A one–two-page, typewritten essay describing yourself and your passion for your area of arts study, including why you selected your college or university program and your planned career path. Be sure to include why you feel your pursuit of your passion is important and the impact you would like your art to have on those who experience it.

Credentials and Acknowledgements

Comprehensive summary of your:

Arts achievements

In and out of school activities (both arts and non-arts related)

Honors and/or special citations received

Letters and Transcripts

Copy of high school transcript

Letter of Recommendation written and signed by a teacher in your field of interest

Letter of Recommendation written and signed by your Guidance Counselor

Please note: if you change the school you wish to attend, you must update the information in this application and inform the MFoA Art Scholarship Committee as soon as possible.

After review of all applicant credentials, the Marblehead Festival of Arts Scholarship Committee will conduct personal interviews with the finalist candidates.
