2014 Marblehead Festival of Arts Film Festival

The Marblehead Festival of Arts invites both aspiring and seasoned filmmakers to submit their short films for its 2014 Film Festival—part of the Marblehead Festival of the Arts which will be held July 3–6, 2014.

The 90 minute outdoor Film Festival will be screened on Thursday, July 3 at 9 pm in Marblehead's Crocker Park. Films selected for showing by the Festival will have the opportunity to win cash and other prizes if they are chosen by the judges and will be eligible for a People's Choice award based on audience balloting.

The selected films will also be shown in Marblehead's Abbot Library during the Festival as will film-related workshops. Additionally, selected films may be screened at the Festival's Winter Film Festival in February 2015.

The Marblehead Festival of Arts, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization comprised of area residents who volunteer their time and services in a variety of capacities. The organization was established in the fall of 1962 to promote and foster artistic events and activities in the town of Marblehead by producing an annual Arts Festival. Today, the Marblehead Festival of Arts (MFoA) produces a summer Arts Festival, sponsors other events throughout the year, and contributes to the development of other local organizations and art projects.

ELIGIBILITY/RULES

- Films genres considered: Fictional Narrative (comedy or drama), Documentary, Animation Music Video and Experimental/Performances
- Films must not exceed a 20-minute total running time
- Your film must have been completed after November 1, 2011
- Entries may have originated in any format, but final works must be submitted on DVD. Video projection is the exhibition format.
- Festival is open to adults, age 18 and over and youth/students under age 18 or students through grade 12. Youth/students will not be subject to submission fee.
- Adult entries must be accompanied by a submission fee of \$10 per film. (*Student entries—no fee*) There is no limit to the number of entries one can submit.
