Marblehead High School Graduate Wins Arts Festival Scholarship

Marblehead MA (June 12, 2009) The Art Scholarship Committee of the Marblehead Festival of Arts is pleased to award this year's annual Art Scholarship to Melissa Cornfeld of Marblehead. This fall, Melissa will be attending the University of Massachusetts in Amherst, majoring in Art.

Earlier this year, Ms. Cornfeld won a prestigious Gold Key award for her art portfolio in the *Boston Globe's* Scholastic Art Awards competition, a prize given to only 150 students of the 3500 Massachusetts applicants who submitted portfolios. She also received an Honorable Mention for an oil and pastel selfportrait in the same competition. During her high school career, Ms. Cornfeld was a member of the National Honor Society and the National Art Honor Society; and she was a member of the Rebel Shakespeare Company, appearing in important roles in the group's productions of *Twelfth Night* and *Richard III.*

The Art Scholarship Committee, consisting of Jim Farrell, Shira Karpo, and Ursina Amsler, selected Melissa from a field of talented young men and women. The \$3000 scholarship is the 24th annual art scholarship awarded by the Marblehead Festival of Arts to a high school senior residing in or attending school in Marblehead and interested in pursuing higher education in the visual arts, performing arts, crafts, music, drama, or writing. The Festival's objective is to encourage graduates interested in pursuing the arts professionally to acquire a sound academic grounding in their chosen fields.
