Marblehead Festival of Arts Hosts Champagne Reception

Marblehead, MA (June 16, 2009) The Marblehead Festival of Arts Champagne Reception and Culinary Arts Tasting is scheduled for Sunday, June 28, from 5 to 7 pm, under a tent at Fort Sewall, overlooking Marblehead Harbor. The Reception is an annual festivity that celebrates the opening of the Marblehead Festival of Arts, to be held this year from July 1 through July 5.

Reggae and Caribbean infused popular music will be provided by Senor Perfecto and the One Drops, a "super group" made up of the best local musicians: Steven Spungin (bass / vocals), Benny Benson (drums), Ken Clark (keyboards), Christine Lucas (vocals), Will Pirone (Moog analog synthesizer / harmonica), Marc O (saxophone), Mike Rivela (guitar), and Mike Kenny (guitar). Dancing is encouraged.

Not to be missed is the raffle for floral arrangements by Flores Mantilla and tickets to Symphony by the Sea concerts. Also part of the tradition is the expressive hats worn by guests who compete for top prizes in the Champagne Reception Hat Contest.

The Champagne Reception and Culinary Arts Tasting is a fund-raising event that helps support the Summer Festival.
