Marblehead MA (April 8, 2010) – The Marblehead Festival of Arts annual Volunteer Information Party will be held Sunday, April 25, from 3:00 to 5:00 PM, at the Corinthian Yacht Club, 1 Nahant Street, on Marblehead Neck. The gathering is a great way to learn about current opportunities to assist the Festival, an all-volunteer organization comprised of more than forty committees working to produce the region's premier summer arts festival, to be held July 1–5. Light refreshments will be served and a cash bar will be available.
