Wanted: Festival Exhibit Entries!

Marblehead, MA (April 12, 2010) — With Spring in the air, Essex County residents are making plans that include the upcoming Marblehead Festival of Arts! Once again, this summer Festival will feature art exhibits in crafts, drawing, painting, printmaking, *plein aire* painting, photography, mixed media, and sculpture; as well as special exhibits featuring youth art, student art, and senior art. People who reside in, work in, or are members of an arts association in Essex County are eligible to enter their works.

Mark your calendars and prepare your artwork for entry! Drop off dates are Wednesday evening, May 19; Saturday morning, May 22; and Thursday evening, May 27. Artists should check the Festival Web site for entry details, including times and locations of drop-offs, and exhibit entry forms that may be downloaded.

After the drop-offs, entries are judged and juried, each exhibit is set up by a committee under the direction of a chairperson, and finally the exhibits are open to the public during the Festival, which will run this year from July 1 through July 5.

Founded in 1962, the Marblehead Festival of Arts is an all-volunteer, not-for-profit organization. Artists and art enthusiasts are invited to become Festival volunteers and join a cast of several hundred individuals who put on this premier event that includes art exhibits, outdoor concerts in Crocker Park, Writers' World, Artisans' Marketplace, and much more.
